## What is TACCLE?

TACCLE or Teachers' Aids on Creating Content for Learning Environments, is a project funded by the EU under its Lifelong Learning Programme. Its aim is to help teachers to develop state of the art content for e-learning in general and for learning environments in particular.

It tries to achieve this by training teachers to create e-learning materials and raising their awareness of e-learning in general. TACCLE will help to establish a culture of innovation in the schools in which they work.

The training is geared to the needs of the classroom teachers but teacher trainers, ICT support staff and resource centre staff may find it useful too!

## What exactly will TACCLE do?

Train teachers to create content for electronic learning environments in the context of an e-learning course.

Enable teachers to identify and decide which ICT tools and content are most useful for particular purposes.

Teach teachers how to create learning objects taking into account information design, web standards, usability criteria and reusability (text, images, animations, audio, video). This will enable (inter)active and cooperative learning processes.

Enhance the quality of e-learning environments in education by training teachers how to use them effectively and by creating resources to help them do so.
